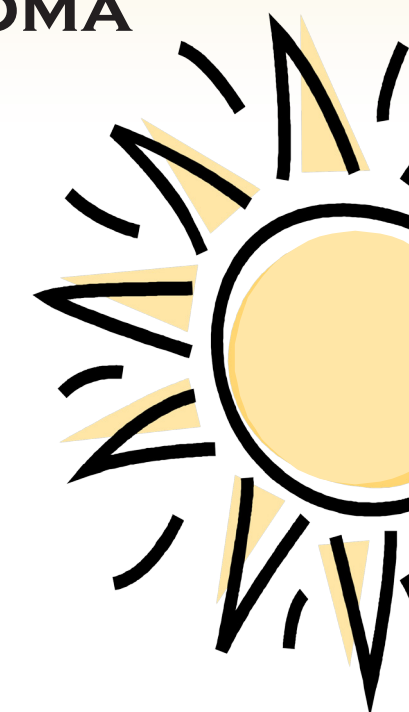

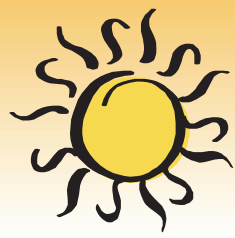

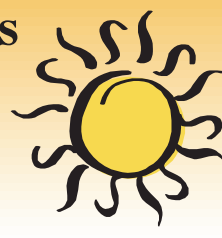




# 2009 American Indian Prevention Services
